We are located at Northcote Ranch near Lake Morena. From interstate 8, take Buckman Springs Road south for 5.3 miles. Turn right on Oak Dr. and go 1.3 miles. Turn left on Molchan Dr. and go .3 miles to Morena Dr. turn left, go 15 yards then immediately turn right into the entrance at 2402 Lake Morena Dr. Watch for the Red Buffalo Signs.

Dear Campers, Welcome to the 26th Annual Manzanita High Mountain Rendezvous! You are responsible for reading and knowing the following rules. The Booshway has final say in any disputes.

FIRES: Due to fire hazard. Fires may be banned at any time. Be prepared with an alternative such as propane. **AN ADULT MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE OF FIRES AT ALL TIMES OR FIRE WILL BE PUT OUT.** A safe area must be cleared around your fire pit. Avoid placing under trees, near brush or by other fire hazards. Keep water bucket and shovel on hand at all times. Remove all traces of your fire upon leaving. No kerosene lanterns!

FIREARMS: NO LOADED FIREARMS IN CAMP AREA. Loaded means any powder down the barrel. Black powder, Muzzle loading round ball only. Open sights only. No painted sights or optical aids. **EYE AND EAR PROTECTION REQUIRED. NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON RANGES.** Period dress required for all events. All powder will be loaded from a powder measure; never directly from a horn or flask. No aggregate or top shooter shoot off events. Open range hours will be posted.

DOGS: Dog owners will be held responsible for any injury or damage caused by their dog. Dogs must be on leash at all times and under your control. **THIS IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT BECAUSE OF THE ANIMALS THAT LIVE ON THE PROPERTY.** Do not walk dogs on trader's row. Dog complaints: 1st. verbal warning, 2nd will be a \$10 fine. 3rd, or refusal to pay fine, you will be asked to leave the rendezvous. **OWNERS MUST PICK UP DOG'S WASTE.**

CHILDREN: children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult while participating in events. Parents will be held responsible for any injury or damage caused by their children.

PRIMITIVE CAMP: Our goal is to create the pre-1850 era by day & night. All visible gear must be reasonably authentic in material & design. Cover up all modern items; plastic, aluminum, etc. Period archery equipment welcome. No composite bows, slingshots, pellet guns or modern cartridge guns allowed. Period clothing is required in primitive camp. LOADING AND UNLOADING IN PRIMITIVE AREA IS LIMITED TO ONCE IN AND ONCE OUT. Unload your vehicle, park it in the long term parking area and then set up camp.

TIN TIPI: no fires allowed- propane only. Water bucket and fire extinguisher required. Generators must remain off between 7 pm and 7 am.

DRIVE SLOWLY AT ALL TIMES. PLEASE CONTAIN AND HAUL OUT YOUR OWN TRASH. PLEASE BRING FULL WATER CONTAINERS WITH YOU. A WATER BUFFALO WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR REFILLS. ALL CAMPERS, INCLUDING THOSE WHO PRE-REGISTERED AND CLUB MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AND SIGN A REGISTRATION FORM UPON ARRIVAL. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN FIREWOOD; THERE MAY NOT BE ANY AVAILABLE AT THE SITE.
